Around your home or during a visit to the Fells, find and identify a species for as many of the following as you can.

- · Reptile
- · Amphibian
- · Flying insect
- · Non-flying insect
- Spider
- · Flowering plant
- · Non-flowering plant
- · Bush or shrub
- · Tree
- · Mammal (if possible, from a safe distance)

If you have access to an iPhone or Android:

i-Naturalist is a free application available for both iPhone and Android users that allows participants to identify plant and animal species. Once you have opened the application, and agreed to remain safe and smart in nature, you can click on the camera option and begin identifying things! Hold the camera over a plant or animal and the application will tell you the species. If you take a picture of your observed plant or animal, the application will provide facts such as where the species is native, related species, and where other people have spotted the same plant or animal.

You can also collect badges on the application when you have observed different types of plants and animals. There are challenges provided by Seek that encourage you to find different categories of species. Once you have completed these challenges, you earn badges! You can follow these challenges or make your own and explore areas around you. The application is a wonderful way to participate in a Science Scavenger Hunt.

Remember to be safe and responsible when handling nature and observing its organisms!
